

FEBC Prayer Target - October, 2024

<u>Tuesday, October 1</u> - Please pray for the nomadic, unreached Mongolian people. May they hear the Gospel and form new communities of believers. We ask for Mongolian churches to remain unified with each other and faithfully share the Good News despite the growing opposition. Lord, open doors for all 28 ethnic people groups to discover the saving grace and love of Jesus Christ.

Wednesday, October 2 - Pray for our evangelistic counselors in Ukraine who are responding to thousands of calls from people searching for peace—and seeing many listeners come to Christ. "I'm completely shut down," said a listener named Sasha. "I only feel anxious now. Help me." Ask the Lord to guide our team as they talk and pray with people like Sasha. May even more come to faith in Jesus Christ.

<u>Thursday, October 3</u> - More than 228 million people live in the country of Pakistan and over 97% practice Islam. The country is also in the midst of economic and political turmoil, which has caused a high inflation rate throughout the nation. Ask the Lord for His grace and provision and for hearts to be open to learn more about Jesus.

<u>Friday, October 4</u> - Please pray for the Hmong people living in Southeast Asia. Many listeners there receive and share radios with their villages. May the power of Jesus shine throughout these village communities and beyond.

<u>Saturday</u>. <u>October 5</u> - Pray for the people of Taiwan. The government has lifted restrictions to allow for communities to be more open. Ask the Lord to use FEBC's team as they broadcast new children and youth programs to reach the next generation with the love of Jesus.

<u>Sunday, October 6</u> - Pray for the Lord to encourage our team in Kyrgyzstan to effectively reach unreached listeners through radio, internet, and social media. FEBC broadcasters in Bishkek, the capital city, have received threats by Muslim extremists. Pray for the Lord's protection over this team as they share the Good News with boldness.

Monday, October 7 - Today, pray for those living in the Philippines who have never heard the Gospel in their heart language. May the Lord guide our local team to the right locations as we plan to build new radio stations to reach even more with the Good News!

<u>Tuesday, October 8</u> - In Vietnam there are over 20 ethnic language broadcasts available to listeners. Pray for God to guide our team as they create content for three new minority languages this year. Also, pray for the people who speak these languages to hear the Gospel message and accept Christ as their Savior.

Wednesday, October 9 - Pray for those living in Laos, a country just north of Thailand. Laos is

one of five remaining communist countries in the world. Pray for our local team as they seek to add new team members to produce more indigenous Christian music to use in their programs and digital media. May the Gospel reach those who are seeking truth and continue to spread to the unreached.

Thursday, October 10 - Today, pray for the 11,000 unreached people in Moldova. Also pray for FEBC's local leadership team as they recruit broadcasters and writers. Several new young digital writers have joined the team, who are very strong with listener interactions, responding to comments, and sharing the Gospel.

<u>Friday, October 11</u> - Please pray for Ihor, a broadcaster for FEBC Ukraine. He recently visited the city of Kropyvnytskyi to meet with a group of young people. He was invited by Sasha, a teen who didn't believe in God until he started watching Ihor's program. He shared how Ihor inspired him to search for God. Please pray for listeners like Sasha, who may come to know the Lord through FEBC's programs.

<u>Saturday, October 12</u> - Pray for the 1.5 million Yao people in Malawi. Please ask for the Lord to anoint FEBC's team as they distribute radios, speak with listeners, and meet with listener clubs. Also, pray for God to guide the process of expanding our radio network to reach even more Yao with the Gospel.

<u>Sunday, October 13</u> - Pray today for the those living in China. May God use the current economic crisis as an opportunity for many Chinese to hear the Gospel and turn to God for salvation and eternal hope. Pray also that the Lord will keep the internet platform open so our team can serve the needs of believers and churches.

Monday, October 14 - Praise God! Listeners in Indonesia are sharing that they are learning more about God and the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. In this country, many people groups remain unreached—about 63% of the total population. Pray for our broadcasters to be filled with the Holy Spirit and for more lives to be changed by the Gospel.

<u>Tuesday, October 15</u> - Because of your faithful partnership, FEBC continues to share the Gospel boldly, grow indigenous leaders, and use advancing technology to reach the unreached. Pray for more people to discover the love of Jesus, like this listener in China, who shared: "Your programs allow me to know God and know myself, and urge us to put God's words into practice. Jesus has become my best friend!"

Wednesday, October 16 - With religious intolerance on the rise, pray for the people of Pakistan. Please pray for the safety of FEBC's staff, local ministries, and churches. Ask for God's protection as believers continue to share the love of Christ with others.

Thursday, October 17 - Praise God for the millions of people all over the world who have tuned into FEBC today and heard the Good News. Thank the Lord for the seeds that have been planted, and for those who have accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior! May the Gospel continue to be proclaimed... until all have heard.

Friday, October 18 - Please pray for the people in Japan. Thousands were devastated by the

recent earthquake on the west coast - the most powerful in 12 years. Over 30,000 people were living in shelters and many suffered the loss of loved ones. Pray for these hurting people and that they will find true hope that can only be found in Jesus Christ.

Saturday, October 19 - Praise God! In India there are 283 million people who can hear the Gospel through FEBC radio programs in eight languages. Ask the Lord to provide direction and creative collaboration for our producers and staff to reach even more listeners who speak other languages.

Sunday, October 20 - Please pray for the unreached people of Chad. As political unrest continues, ask the Lord to anoint the pastors and churches who partner with FEBC as they share the Good News with those who are suffering and afraid.

<u>Monday, October 21</u> - Thank God for successful partnerships with 200 churches and mission agencies in Thailand. Last Christmas, over 30,000 children received gifts and heard the story of the Gospel together with their families.

Tuesday, October 22 - Please pray for the 443 unreached people groups in China. A listener shared: "I started listening to FEBC and now I feel I'm a totally different person. My life has changed!" Pray for more people in China to hear the Good News and embrace the love of Christ, just like this listener.

Wednesday, October 23 - Please pray for our new station, Victory FM in Cuamba, Mozambique. Pray also for our team of new broadcasters as they begin to produce programs and share the message of Jesus with listeners.

Thursday, October 24 - Thank the Lord for opportunities to reach people in North Korea. Despite religious restrictions, the Gospel message is reaching the lost in this country. Pray for even more people to come to know Jesus as Savior and Lord.

Friday, October 25 - Please pray for the unreached people living in Cambodia. May listeners experience the peace of Christ and be moved to share the Gospel with family and friends. Pray for the new Ministry Center being built, that all will go smoothly with construction.

<u>Saturday</u>, <u>October 26</u> - Pray for FEBC's team as they boldly share the Good News in Central Asia. May the Holy Spirit provide spiritual discernment and move in the hearts of those who are in need of everlasting hope.

<u>Sunday, October 27</u> - Please continue to pray for the people of Ukraine. Recently, the country has been under heavy attack, with dozens of deaths, including a rocket strike into a children's hospital. Also, please pray for FEBC's team in eastern Ukraine who provide counseling, prayer, and the message of hope to thousands each month through a telephone helpline.

Monday, October 28 - Thank God for new opportunities for youth in Kazakhstan to share the Gospel through social media. Our team has received strong responses from people who are interested in faith and church. Pray that more listeners in this traditionally muslim country will accept Jesus as their Savior and share the Good News with others.

Tuesday, October 29 - Pray for the people of Myanmar, especially families who have lost their homes to incinerations from the Junta Military. Over 29,000 homes were burned just last year. Ask the Lord to make a way for all displaced people to return to their villages and rebuild their homes. May God use FEBC's broadcasts to offer messages of hope to people living there.

<u>Wednesday, October 30</u> - Thank God for FEBC's successful partnerships in Mongolia. Three new stations will soon go on the air! May the broadcasts from these new locations lead thousands of people in Mongolia to discover the saving love of Jesus Christ.

<u>Thursday, October 31</u> - Pray for people in India. Ask the Lord for energy, creativity, and good health for FEBC broadcasters to share the hope and peace of Jesus. May the Holy Spirit bring an increase in new listeners as well.

Unreached Prayer Focus: Mongolians

Thirty years ago, Mongolia was a Soviet state. Communism and atheism were the country's official beliefs, but many also practiced Buddhism and Shamanism. **There were no more than eight known Christian believers in the entire nation.**

During the 1989 Lausanne Congress in the Philippines, hundreds of Christian leaders and missionaries focused their prayers on Mongolia asking God for a breakthrough. Little did they know their prayers were about to be answered. The next year, the USSR broke apart, Mongolia gained independence, and the first Mongolian Bible translation was completed. The first Christian church was planted in May of 1991.

Today Christian believers number approximately 2% of the total population (as reported by the Joshua Project). The slow progress is understandable. Mongolia is an enormous country with extreme temperatures. Many still live a nomadic lifestyle in hard-to-reach areas. Recently the political pressures from Russia and China (its only two neighbors) have intensified, and opposition to the Gospel has increased.
