



## FEBC Prayer Target – November, 2024

**Friday, November 1** - Please pray for the unreached **Lao** people today. Ask the Lord for many more communities to embrace the Gospel and accept Jesus Christ as Savior. Also, may God bring unity and protection for those who are persecuted for their faith and to raise up trained, local Christian pastors to lead and guide churches.

**Saturday, November 2** - Pray for those living in **Hong Kong**. Please pray for our team as they host and visit audiences and ministry partners in this region. May these gatherings bring encouragement to believers and renew efforts to share the Good News with more unreached people.

**Sunday, November 3** - A listener in **Cambodia** recently shared, *"Thank you for the many encouraging programs offered through FEBC! To get to know Jesus better, I will spend more time listening and learning about His words."* Praise God for the spiritual growth of this listener. May they begin to share Jesus with others in their community.

**Monday, November 4** - *"I found your program and started listening," said a listener in **Russia**. "You showed me a different side of Christianity... and now, I want to go to church to learn more!"* Pray others in Russia discover the Good News and have open hearts to learn more just like this listener did.

**Tuesday, November 5** - Harsh forms of Islam are on the rise in **Kazakhstan**. Evangelism outside of a church building is technically illegal. Those who do come to faith in Christ are seen as abandoning their heritage and face hostility. Pray for wisdom for our team as they continue to build relationships with listeners. Also pray that God will open new doors for the Gospel in this country.

**Wednesday, November 6** - In many cities across **Ukraine**, women with little or no exposure to Jesus are coming together to study the Bible. Several are now attending church, and others have placed their faith in Christ and been baptized! Please pray for the Lord to guide our team as they lead Bible studies to reach many women who are struggling in this time of war.

**Thursday, November 7** - Please pray for the people of **Thailand**. There are over 61 million people living there that have never heard about Jesus and His great love for them. May God use FEBC's team to reach spiritually hungry people and open their hearts to accept Jesus as Savior and Lord.

**Friday, November 8** - Please pray for the people of **Indonesia**. Pray also for FEBC's team sharing their radio broadcasts and Bible messages on social media in order to help children and teens be "rooted in God" by reading the Bible daily. May the truths of God's Word come alive in their hearts as they learn more about His never-ending love.

**Saturday, November 9** - Pray for the people of **Malawi**. Many listeners are hearing FEBC's Gospel broadcasts through local listener clubs, where they can discuss the programs in a small group setting. Recently, many listener clubs have grown because people heard FEBC broadcasts in their own language and accepted Christ as their Savior. Praise the Lord!

**Sunday, November 10** - Did you know there are over 4 million unreached people living in **Taiwan**? Pray for each local listener to be open to receive the love of Christ. Also, ask for the Holy Spirit to guide FEBC teams creating radio broadcasts and podcasts.

**Monday, November 11** - Please pray for FEBC's team in **Mongolia** as they work to launch several new radio stations. Pray for strong local church partnerships and ask the Holy Spirit to soften the hearts of the unreached in Mongolia.

**Tuesday, November 12** - Please pray for the people of **Ukraine** who have lost family members during the ongoing war. Rebecca, an FEBC listener, lost her brother in the war a year ago. *"Thank you for being there for me as I was going through a really difficult time. I was looking for answers, and you helped me find them. And now I'm in church!"*

**Wednesday, November 13** - Pray for Gospel broadcasts to reach more listeners in **Japan**. With less than 1% of the population Christian, many are living without hope. Our listeners continue to share that they remain connected to Jesus through FEBC and receive spiritual nourishment every day.

**Thursday, November 14** - Today, pray for the people of **China**. Many are struggling with strict laws enforced by the government to control the Church. Pray

for God to give Chinese believers strength and courage. May the Lord guide our FEBC broadcasters and live-stream team to share the Gospel despite current challenges.

**Friday, November 15** - Listeners from **South Korea** have told us that they did not believe in Jesus until their family members shared FEBC broadcasts with them. After much prayer, they decided to put their faith in Christ. Praise God for life-changing moments like these! May more hearts come to know Jesus in South Korea.

**Saturday, November 16** - Please pray for the people of **India**. Many listeners are seeking God as they tune into our programs through various media channels such as radio, YouTube, and Instagram Live. Also, pray that our partnerships around the country will continue to grow so that more unreached people may discover the love of Jesus.

**Sunday, November 17** - Continue to pray for soldiers in **Ukraine** who are on the frontlines, facing heavy fighting and terrible losses. Over the last year, hundreds of radios have been handed out to soldiers and their families. They are grateful to hear FEBC broadcasts each day.

**Monday, November 18** - Thank God for the successful completion of our new radio tower in **Cambodia**. Now listeners can continue hearing the Good News on 99.5 Family FM. May the Lord draw even more of the unreached in Cambodia to hear and discover the love of Jesus through this station.

**Tuesday, November 19** - Please pray for those living in **Myanmar**. People all over the country are living in fear and the military takeover has caused great anxiety. Also, superstitious beliefs continue to spread the message of paying money to local idols to ensure peace. Pray that people there will hear the true message of the Gospel and experience peace from Jesus that passes all understanding.

**Wednesday, November 20** - We are encouraged by listeners from **Laos** who are hearing and responding to our broadcasts—many through Facebook Live. But many are also being persecuted for their faith in Christ. Please pray for continued protection and spiritual growth for these listeners and their communities.

**Thursday, November 21** - Thank God for the opportunity to reach the people of **Kyrgyzstan** through FEBC's network of six FM stations. Pray for partnerships with

local churches to grow. Ask for God's help to create more Christian broadcasts on the radio, internet, and social media to reach the unreached.

**Friday, November 22** - Please pray for the 2.5 million people of **Moldova**. Listeners can hear FEBC's Russian and Romanian language broadcasts through social media. Pray for interest and openness to the Gospel they hear on this platform.

**Saturday, November 23** - Pray for the people living in **Russia**. Widespread suffering and economic devastation is affecting everyone. Pray for repentance, revival, and renewal. May the love of Jesus prevail in this dark time for their country.

**Sunday, November 24** - Pray for the people of **Mongolia**. More than 98% of Mongolia's 3.3 million people do not know Christ and are still considered unreached. Pray for God to guide FEBC leaders and broadcasters so that more will come to faith in Mongolia.

**Monday, November 25** - People living in **Vietnam** can hear FEBC broadcasts in numerous ethnic languages as well as in Vietnamese. Pray for the hearts of listeners as they learn of God's love. Pray also for the youth, who are more open to the Gospel, to accept Christ. Pray that they may lead older generations to faith.

**Tuesday, November 26** - In **Mozambique**, FEBC ministers to unreached people groups who are predominantly Muslim and many are also exposed to witchcraft. Pray the people living there will be moved to tune in and discover the lifechanging love of Jesus. Also, ask the Lord to protect our local staff against terrorism and guide them with effective paths to expand the reach of the ministry.

**Wednesday, November 27** - Pray for people in the **Philippines**. Many were injured and displaced after the large earthquake in the province of Abra. Local government reported collapsed structures, landslides, and road damages in this mountainous region. FEBC's staff was kept safe during the event. Pray for God's guidance as they broadcast the message of hope in Christ.

**Thursday, November 28** - "Let us come before him with thanksgiving..." (Psalm 95:2). As you celebrate Thanksgiving today, take a moment to thank God for the millions of people all over the world who have tuned into FEBC and heard the Good

News. Thank the Lord for the seeds that have been planted, and for those who have accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior!

**Friday, November 29** - Pray for the people of **Belarus**. Many are being reached through social media by our online broadcasts from Russia. Please pray for God to use FEBC's team to clearly share the Gospel with listeners longing for comfort and truth.

**Saturday, November 30** - Praise God for the new transmitters and antenna installed at our new site in Blantyre, **Malawi!** May God use our team to broadcast the message of hope and salvation to thousands of new listeners in this area.

### ***Unreached Prayer Focus: Lao***

The Lao are a people group of around 4 million, who live primarily in Laos; a country between Thailand and Vietnam. The Lao live in one of the poorest countries in the world, with many people living in small, rural communities near rivers, surviving by fishing and farming to make a living. **Evangelical Christianity among the Lao in Laos is only 2%**, with the major religion being Buddhism. Laos is one of the least free countries in the world, and the communist government is considered one of the most stringent in Southeast Asia.

Despite the religious persecution they face, there has been rapid church growth among the Lao. Indigenous Lao lead almost all churches and evangelism efforts. The largest is the Lao Evangelical Church, however, there is also an entire underground house-church movement growing without government approval.

These churches face a pastoral crisis. It is estimated **90% of all trained church leaders left Laos in 1975**, when the Laotian Communist party took over the country. Today, most congregations lack a trained pastor. Persecution remains common. Village elders and gatekeepers often accuse Christians of changing their culture.
